This two year training programme provides learners with the opportunity to acquire the education/training and social skills needed to progress to part-time employment, further training or specific skills training.

It also offers a comprehensive range of work experience placements in the Retail, Hospitality, Catering, Horticultural, Industrial Sewing and Printing business.

In addition the programme aims to:

- Help the person identify his/her skills.
- Identify from their work experience placements which vocational area best suits their abilities, interests and skills.
- Practise a range of personal and interpersonal skills which will enable the person to be more effective in their working lives.
- Identify progression routes to the open labour market, supported employment, community co-operatives or further training.

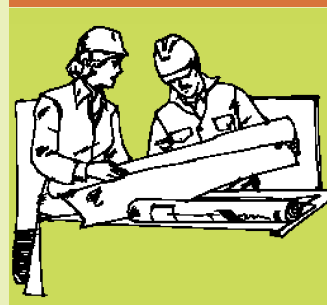
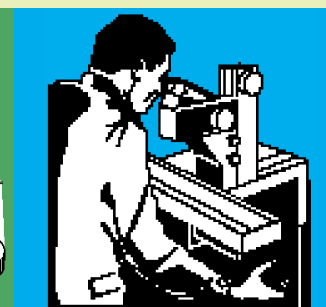
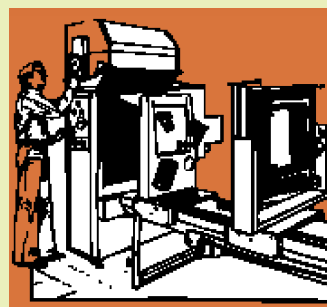
